QAYG Strippy Quilt for Care Leavers



Quilts for Care Leavers QAYG Workshop

Saturday 28 Sept 10 – 4, drop in anytime

Methodist Church, Sea Rd/Cliffe Rd, Barton on Sea BH25 7PA

We are taking the pressure off the long arm quilt volunteers AND making a start at using up our scraps hosting a "Quilt As You Go " workshop for this get together.

We will provide you with backing fabric and batting (already cut to 12 ½ - 13"" square) and as much tea/coffee and home made cake as you can manage! We have some donated fabric and scraps, but this is a great opportunity to use up some of your own.

The Plan

We will cover the surface of the batting with 45 degree diagonal "quilt as you go" strip piecing using scraps. We will trim squares to 12" and join them together using sashing strips and then bind. If that doesn't appeal, choose one of our quilt packs to sew up

Top Tips

- A walking foot on your sewing machine might make life easier but it is not essential
- Use whatever width strips you like, but please sew strips DIAGONALLY and PARALLEL
- Choose slightly wider strips to cover the square block corners (central stripe and outer corners) without any seam joins to give us a cleaner sashing seam with less bulk
- Machine sew right to the edge, but no need to reverse stitch, finish off ends or sew around finished blocks
