Our guest speaker at our February meeting was the wonderful Sandie Lush who inspired us with her talk "From Old Cloth to Wholecloth"; illustrating her presentation with a great slide show and some beautiful examples of her varied portfolio of quilts. Sandie also facilitated a Welsh Quilting workshop the following day when she generously and entertainingly shared her skills and ideas with us. We came away with so many plans for future handstitched projects....!

Our March meeting is, of course, our AGM but we will also be introducing a new and exciting creative initiative for the group.

For the April meeting we are hosting a 'come and sew' evening with a difference – members of the committee will be facilitating two activities using curtain rings and embroidery threads - Dorset Buttons and Shisha Mirrors. I think most of us are familiar with the concept, if not the process, of Dorset Buttons, but shisha mirror embroidery may be new to some of you so here are some pictures to give you an idea of what's on offer. We will provide the rings for both activities, and the mirrors, the fabric and some embellishments, but we do ask you to bring along your embroidery flosses and Perle cottons and a needle that you can thread easily (although help will be on hand.....!) However, we can also supply you with threads and needles if you forget!

Lovely Nicola's Fabrics will be our trader for the evening so don't forget your shopping list and purse.

We ate a lot of cake, recognised the joy of a design wall and learnt that a ¼" foot and seam allowance varies hugely from one machine to another.

Thank you to all who came along and donated their time and expertise to a very successful, friendly and productive day.

We will be working on a choice of 4 different patterns next time, more details on this and the date to follow.
